

Town of Castle Valley
Parking Restriction and Road Use Ordinance:
Castle Valley Drive, Keogh Lane through Upper 80 Cul-de-sac
Ordinance # 2005-2

WHEREAS the Town of Castle Valley (Town) recognizes that it maintains its road shoulders for drainage and not as parking; and

WHEREAS the Town allows hunting bordering Upper Castle Valley Drive on both sides, between Keogh Lane and the end of Castle Valley Drive at the cul de sac, except for within private property within the boundaries of the Upper 80, and

WHEREAS the Town recognizes the hazard created by parking along a road with no suitable shoulder: as well as the danger presented by parking on a road not easily visible from the areas where hunting is permitted; and

WHEREAS the Town finds that it is in the best interest of the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Town to regulate activities and uses that may adversely affect road safety.

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE VALLEY, UTAH, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Purpose and Intent.

The purpose of this Ordinance is to protect, preserve unimpeded traffic flow in order to safeguard the public health, safety and welfare of current and future Town residents and visitors. This Ordinance establishes regulations for No Parking or Standing on Castle Valley Drive.

Section 2. Applicability.

The provisions of this Ordinance shall be effective within the boundaries of the Town of Castle Valley along Castle Valley Drive between Keogh Lane and the end of Castle Valley Drive at the cul-de-sac.

It shall be the responsibility of any person or persons using Castle Valley Drive in motorized vehicles to conform and comply with the applicable provisions contained in this Ordinance. Ignorance of this provision shall not excuse any violations of the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. Restrictions.

There shall be No Parking or Standing along Castle Valley Drive from Keogh Lane to the cul-de-sac at the upper end of the Upper 80 from September 20th through October 31, annually.

All motorized vehicles shall remain on existing, designated roads and trails within the boundaries of Castle Valley.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon first posting.

Section 5. Penalty.

Whoever violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a violation, subject to a penalty of \$250.

Section 6. Severability.

If any part, section, paragraph or subsection of this Ordinance, or the application thereof, is held to be invalid, the remainder of this Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.
