ORDINANCE 2022-1 AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE 2008-3 ESTABLISHING THE CASTLE VALLEY  
ROAD COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Regular staff meetings with the Mayor and Road Manager have proven to be more productive than Road Committee Meetings, and

WHEREAS, the Monthly Road Report will be posted on the Town website and bulletin boards one week prior to Town Council Meetings, and

WHEREAS, citizens/taxpayers are encouraged to participate in Town Council Meetings regarding questions they may have regarding Road Reports as well as other road concerns, and

WHEREAS, citizens/taxpayers are encouraged to contact the Mayor and/or the Road Manager directly regarding road concerns and questions, and

WHEREAS, the Town Council has the authority under Utah Code 10-3b-403 to re-assign administrative duties

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF CASTLE VALLEY:

1. The Castle Valley Road Committee is hereby terminated by way of this ordinance;
2. The Town Council will periodically review the job description and priorities for the Road Department Manager;
3. The Town Council must approve all major personnel actions regarding the Road Department Manager (i.e., hiring, firing, raises, etc.), and the Mayor does the Personnel Evaluation of the Road Department Manager;

EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon public posting.




