

2024 Burning protocol

Spring 2024 Burn Window is now open until we are notified otherwise. No matter what the Castle Valley Fire danger Index needs to be “moderator” or below to even start this process, the Index is posted up by the mail boxes.

The Process:

Log into the Utah Division of Air Quality

<https://air.utah.gov/OpenBurning/form/index.php>

Select: Castle Valley

That will bring up the next 3 days and if they are burn days or not.

Fill out the application and submit.

Print your permit or write down your Permit number

Call the Grand County Sheriff Dispatch 259-4321 and give them your permit #. They also want to be called when you are done burning.

If you do not have the Internet call Utah Division of Air Quality 801-536-4000 Mon-Fri.

*****IMPORTANT** No matter if it is a burn day and you have your permit if it gets windy DON'T burn. Common sense right! Mornings are generally less windy than afternoons so plan ahead.
