Grand County schools are now dismissed for the next 2 weeks as well.

Castle Valley Town Hall and our branch of the Grand County Library are also now closed. This includes all exercise, yoga, OA, photo club and entry by those with keys who are not staff or an official.

The Town office will keep normal hours M-W 9:00am -1:00pm by telephone only at this time.

Public meetings will continue as scheduled unless something changes. We do ask that you please do not attend if you are sick or have been around anyone who is, let's keep the risk of spread of anything down so we can protect the health of our residents. We will have a lower max occupancy during public meetings so please only attend if necessary. State law requires municipalities to hold one public meeting a month and we must do so to pay our bills, but we want to limit everyone's public exposure at this time.

If you are someone who has been advised to stay at home to limit your exposure and you need help getting supplies from Moab, please call the town hall at 259-9828, or myself at 259-1064 and leave us a message. We are working on finding people who are available to pick things up for those in need of help.
