



This Coming Week

Daytime Work

Work is scheduled to begin August 14th.

Daytime work hours are 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Monday - Friday.

This work includes:

- * Installing a Cattle Guard near milepost 18.
- * Some earthwork with short sections of lane closures with traffic reduced to one lane with short delays.
- * Some locations with multiple culvert repairs that may require **up to a one mile closure with a pilot car** as the contractor works to repair multiple culverts at the same time. While this work is taking place you can expect traffic delays of up to 15 minutes.

All of these operations are expected to commence and finish between August 14th and the 26th.

Nighttime Work

Work is scheduled to commence the night of August 27th.

Nighttime work hours are 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.

Commuters traveling along SR-128 between the hours of 7 p.m. and 7 a.m. will encounter construction work with traffic limited to a single lane with up to fifteen minute delays in the work zone.

Once work begins, crews are scheduled to work nightly from Sunday night through Friday morning each week. If necessary the work schedule may be altered to meet the project needs.

We hope you will share this information with anyone else that may benefit from these weekly updates. The purpose of the updates is to provide the most current work schedule and expected impacts from week to week along SR-128

If the schedule is moved forward we will alert you of the change.

As work commences, crews will be working along the roadway to widen shoulders, work on guardrails, and do lane leveling in the roadway to improve the ride quality. Once lane leveling has taken place, crews will install a layer of new pavement to the road surface to prolong the life of the road. This work will occur from the Junction of US-191 and SR-128 to Hittle Bottom (see map below).

As we receive the updated work schedule each week, we will share it with you here along with the expected impacts.

What to Expect

Work Hours The Bulk of this project will be completed nightly from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m. from Sunday Night - Friday Morning.

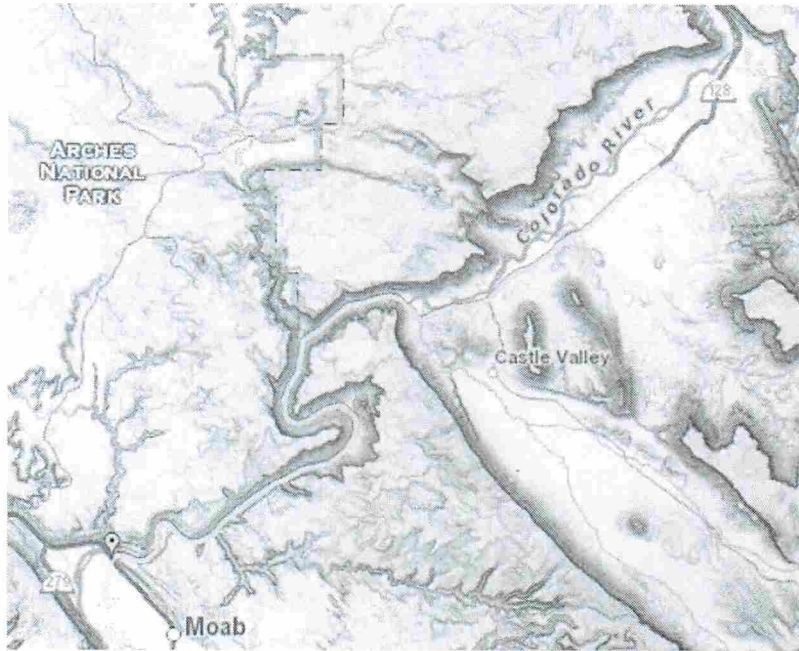
Occasionally there will be work for shorter periods during daytime hours.

Expected Completion is late December 2017

Impacts

In the construction zone, traffic will be reduced to a single lane with delays of up to fifteen minutes. Please be cautious and considerate of workers and other drivers.

Please note that this schedule is subject to change due to weather or materials availability.

Project Overview

Sections of State Route 128 will receive an asphalt overlay to fill in ruts and widen shoulders. Some pullouts will be paved for better access onto SR-128 from the river. After the lane leveling has taken place, crews will install a layer of new pavement to the road surface to prolong the life of the road. Additionally, guardrail will be placed in selected areas to reduce the likelihood of errant vehicles leaving the roadway.

Work is expected to be substantially complete by the end of December 2017.
