

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDINANCE NO. 2008-1

AN ORDINANCE BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE VALLEY, UTAH PROVIDING FOR THE COMPENSATION OF THE TOWN CLERK/RECORDER FOR THE TOWN OF CASTLE VALLEY

WHEREAS, the Town of Castle Valley desires to supersede Ordinance 2006-1, and set the salary for the Clerk/Recorder at \$20,000 per year, and,

Whereas, the Town of Castle Valley now has an Employee Policy Manual that describes per Diem and mileage compensation for all employees, officers and members of the governing body,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE VALLEY, UTAH, THAT:

1. Repealer: All previous salary or compensation ordinances and/or resolutions regarding The Town Clerk/Recorder hereby are repealed.
2. Compensation: The annual compensation of the Clerk Recorder for the Town of Castle Valley, shall be as follows:

3. Payment: The Clerk/Recorder shall be paid monthly, following the regularly scheduled Town Council meeting by delivery of a check drawn on the municipal checking account to the Town Clerk/Recorder personally or by mailing the check to the officer at his or her home, postage prepaid.
4. Per Diem and Mileage: The Clerk/Recorder shall receive mileage and per Diem at the rates described in the Employee Manual for the Town of Castle Valley
5. Effective Date: This resolution shall become effective immediately.
