**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT ROBERT'S RULES OF ORDER TO GOVERN
THE CONDUCT OF ALL TOWN COUNCIL MEETINGS OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE
VALLEY.**

The resolution is as follows:

Whereas the Utah Municipal Code 10-3-606 requires the formal written adoption of rules to govern procedures for all municipal meetings, the Town of Castle Valley shall adopt the following procedural rules.

Be it resolved by the Town of Castle Valley in Grand County, Utah, that all meetings of the Castle Valley Town Council shall be governed by and conducted in accordance with the rules contained in the current edition of Robert's Rules of Order Newly Revised in all cases to which they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with any special rules of order the meeting may adopt.
