**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE TOWN OF CASTLE VALLEY 2022 EMERGENCY  
OPERATIONS PLAN**

**WHEREAS** the Town of Castle Valley recognizes that planning and preparing for emergencies in advance can reduce potential harm to people and property within our community from the threat of natural or human-caused events such as earthquake, fire, flood, terrorism, or other hazards; and the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within Castle Valley; and

**WHEREAS** the Town of Castle Valley recognizes the importance of a unified and consistent system to prepare for, respond to and recover from disasters and emergencies, and

**WHEREAS**, an Emergency Operations Plan ("EOP") provides the framework for emergency response and emergency management in the Town during disasters, and

**WHEREAS**, the overall objective and emergency management for the Town is to ensure the effective management of response forces and resources in preparing for and responding to situations associated with natural, human-caused and national security emergencies, and

**WHEREAS** the Town Council of the Town of Castle Valley believes it is in the best interest of the Town to adopt "The 2022 Emergency Operations Plan".

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF CASTLE VALLEY, UTAH, THAT:**

1. The 2022 Emergency Operations Plan for the Town of Castle Valley is hereby adopted.
2. This Resolution will take effect immediately upon passage.

Passed, Adopted, and Approved by the Town Council of The Town of Castle Valley in open session on the 15 day of June, 2022 by the following vote:




