ROAD MAINTENANCE

- Gravel was spread on most roads, and touch-up/missed spots will be graveled if weather permits.
- Minor flood damage repairs on Upper 80, Keogh, Taylor, Castle Creek and Homestead.

PROJECTS

- We are currently working on drainage maintenance due to flood season and in preparation for winter.
- Maintenance projects on equipment will be beginning shortly.

MATERIALS

- Most of the road base has been spread for the year, we may do touch-up in spots.
- We are currently organizing our order for the yearly gravel/material allotment.

REQUISITIONS

- Hydraulic oil barrel.
- Oil catchment system.
- Potential Work truck (fire dept. vehicle).

ACQUISITIONS

- New Grader Batteries
- Parts for backhoe service. (Filters and Oils)

EQUIPMENT

- Backhoe
 - Operational
 - Fuel gauge circuit failure.
- Ford Dump Truck
 - Dump Bed/hydraulic failure, requires flush and refill of hydraulic oil.
 - Emergency use only.
- Grader
 - Alternator failed, was repaired.
 - Operational.
- Grizzly Rock Separator
 - Lifting hooks were repaired.
 - Operational.

FACILITIES

- Winterization is in progress, all critical items are done.

TRAINING

- Nothing to report at this time.

BUDGET

- We are currently within our budget for the year.

WORK SCHEDULE
