ROAD MAINTENANCE

- Homestead ditches cleared and resurfaced and had some gravel added.
- Lower Cliffview/Castle Creek mowed & overhanging trees trimmed.
- Meadow Lane ditches cleared and resurfaced.
 - Asphalt patch was removed prior to work.

PROJECTS

- We are currently working on drainage maintenance due to flood season and in preparation for winter.

- Priority spots are places where mud is likely/there is excessive silt from the ditches. (Current Spots are Homestead, Lower W. Pope, Lower W. Holyoak.
